Thomas H. Robinson of Chestertown, MD, died at his home on Wednesday, September 19, 2007. He was 86.

Mr. Robinson was born in Chestertown, MD, the son of the late Robert Lee and Susie Lee Hadaway Robinson.

Mr. Robinson was a Line Manager for the C&P Telephone Co. for many years. Prior to his long career with the telephone company, Mr. Robinson served in the United States Army during WWII and fought in the Battle of the Bulge where he received the Bronze Star.

Mr. Robinson spent many years playing and coaching baseball and softball in Kent & Queen Anne's County. On April 6, 2002, Mr. Robinson was honored by being inducted into the Maryland Amateur Softball Association Hall of Fame. His love for sports and youth has always been important as he was one of the founding members of the Kent County Peewee football league. Mr. Robinson loved to fish and crab and was an avid Fox hunter for most of his life. Most recently, he became interested in horse racing and enjoyed that time as well.

Mr. Robinson was a member of the Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post, Chestertown, MD, and the Chestertown Elks lodge #2409.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Robinson was predeceased by his wife Margaret Ann Robinson in 1992; brother, Bozy Robinson; and a son-in-law, Michael Leap. He is survived by two daughters, Donna Mills and her husband, Herb, of Chestertown, MD and daughter Patricia Leap also of Chestertown, MD; and a brother, Ned Robinson also of Chestertown, MD.

Graveside services will be held on Saturday September 22, 2007, at 11am in the Chester Cemetery, Chestertown, MD.
