GRASONVILLE, MD: Thomas Gordon Haddaway died Monday, October 02, 2006 at Easton Memorial Hospital. He was 83 years old.

Mr. Haddaway was born on February 6, 1923, the son of the late Frank and Edna Haddaway. After school Mr. Haddaway entered the service and served in WWII and the Korean War. In 1951, he was honorably discharged and went to work for the State of Maryland full time as a Steam Fitter.

Thomas Haddaway was also known as the "Whittlin Man", because he carved chains, anchors, peach seeds and animal bones. Most of the carvings he made were given away. He worked in the Volunteer Fire Department of Grasonville, #2 for 48 years. Mr. Haddaway loved to watch the boats being launched at the Kent Narrows.

Mr. Haddaway is survived by his two sons; Lawrence Haddaway of Baltimore, MD, and Derek Haddaway and his wife Debby of Ormond Beach, FL; a nephew, Carlton Haddaway and his wife Sharon of Grasonville, MD; five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren; and a brother, Vernon Haddaway of Kent Island.
