February 6, 1923 - May 31, 2013

Thomas Frederick Knop, aka Mr. Wonderful, 90, of Grasonville, MD, went home to be with the Lord on May 31, 2013.

Born on February 6, 1923, in Detroit, MI, he was the son of the late Ludwig and Anna Janke Knop. He graduated from Western High School and immediately enlisted in the Army in 1941. As a World War II veteran, he served under General Patton and Dwight Eisenhower in the Third Army, 20th Corp, 69 Signal Battalion in the European theatre. He served as a Technician 5th grade and received the status of Corporal as a cryptographer. His Battalion received the Meritorious Service Unit Plaque. Upon discharge from the service, he worked for Michigan Bell Telephone and lived in GrossPointe Woods, MI. He moved in 2010 with his wife to Maryland to spend their remaining years on the waters of the beautiful Chesapeake Bay.

He is survived by his loving wife of 65 years, Elizabeth; his children, Kathleen C. Moldenhauer (Raymond) of Queenstown, and Karl M. Knop (Barbara) of Allen Park, MI; his grandchildren, Keven Moldenhauer, Heidi Rayner, Eric Knop, and, Tracey Weborg; and his great-grandchildren, Sadie, Parker, Alyssa, Lily, Connor, Sawyer, Molly, and Andrew.
