



## Thomas Lane

Thomas Edward Lane of Chestertown, MD died on April 21, 2005 at Elsmere Veterans Hospital in Wilmington, Delaware. He was 99.

Born in Centreville, MD on March 11, 1906, he was the son of the late, Thomas Edward and Helen Howkins Lane. He was the husband of the late Frances Mary Lane who predeceased him on June 21, 1992.

He worked on the family's farm in Centreville at a young age and began working with Church Hill Lumber Company in 1939. In 1943 at the age of 37, Mr. Lane enlisted in the U.S. Army and served with the 977th Engineer Maintenance Company during WWII at the Battle of the Bulge in the European Theatre. He was honorably discharged in 1945.

Mr. Lane returned to work with Church Hill Lumber Company where he worked until the late 1970's when he retired with 43 years of service.

He enjoyed crabbing, building boats and clocks, and gardening. Mr. Lane was a member of the Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36 in Chestertown, MD and the Disabled American Veterans.

Mr. Lane is survived by two step sons, Frank Landa of Newark, Delaware and Jack Landa of Chestertown, Maryland; a daughter, Dawn Lane Dionne of Pasadena, Maryland; eight grandchildren and eleven great grandchildren.

One son, Thomas E. Lane, Jr. and a grandson, Chris Landa predeceased him.

Funeral services will be held with military honors on Monday, April 25, 2005 at 11:00 A.M. at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, Maryland where relatives and friends may call on Sunday, April 24, 2005 between the hours of 7:00 and 9:00 P.M.

Interment will be in Woodlawn Cemetery near Easton, Maryland.
