



## Dr. Thomas G. Maloney Jr.

August 8, 1925 - April 12, 2017

Thomas G. Maloney, MD, was born on August 8, 1925 in Washington, D.C. He was the son of the late Thomas G. Maloney, Sr. and Helen Irene Brennan.

After graduating from Gonzaga College High School in 1943, Thomas enlisted in the Navy and served during WW II. Upon returning to Washington, D.C., he attended Georgetown University, where he received his Bachelor's degree, and Georgetown Medical School, to receive a Doctor of Medicine in 1953. While at medical school, he met his future wife, Mary Beck. Together they would open a medical practice in Hyattsville, Maryland, and practice Family Medicine for 40 years. In 1997, they retired to the Eastern Shore, where they had maintained a summer home since 1972.

Thomas was a life member of the VFW and a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church in Chester, MD. Together, Thomas and Mary attended classes at Chesapeake College IAL in Wye Mills, MD and they were very active with the Black Thorn Stick Irish Dancing Group. He was an unpublished poet, lyricist, and scholar.

He is survived by his beloved wife, Mary Beck Maloney, MD; six children; Susan McNally, Daniel Maloney, Michael Maloney, Teresa Maloney, Christopher Maloney, and Kathleen Howard; 18 grandchildren; and 7 great grandchildren. Two sons, Thomas Maloney and Joseph Maloney, and his sister Margaret Jones all predeceased him.

A visitation will be held on Monday, April 24 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, PA in Chester, MD. Family and friends may visit from 2PM-4PM and 6PM-8PM. Funeral mass will be held on Tuesday, April 25 at 11:30AM at St. Christopher's Catholic Church in Chester, MD. Interment will follow at Maryland Veterans Cemetery Crownsville in Crownsville, MD.
