



Thomas Henry Meushaw Jr

September 8, 1935 - November 28, 2011

Thomas Henry Meushaw, Jr., 76, of Easton, MD, died on Monday, November 28, 2011, at the Memorial Hospital in Easton due to complications from Alzheimer's disease.

Born on September 8, 1935, in Baltimore City, he was the son of the late Thomas Henry Meushaw, Sr., and Thelma Shumaker Meushaw.

He graduated from Catonsville High School in 1953. He enlisted in the US Army in 1957 and was honorably discharged in 1959.

Mr. Meushaw was employed by several businesses in Baltimore as an accountant. He began working for the District Court of Maryland in Annapolis in the finance department. Prior to his retirement in 2001, after 31 years of service, he had advanced to fiscal director as the Assistant Chief Clerk of Finance in Annapolis at headquarters. Thomas was a wonderful "boss," treating everyone fairly and kindly. Besides loving his family very much, Mr. Meushaw loved and cared deeply for his job and for all the people that worked for him.

Mr. Meushaw spent the last five years of his life at the Rayland Acres Assisted Living Home in Trappe, MD, after being diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease. He was given excellent care for each of those five years.

He is survived by his wife of 23 years, Lyn C. Meushaw of Easton, whom he married in 1988; his beloved children, Joseph Tyler Meushaw and Abbeygale Malloy Meushaw; a brother, Douglas Meushaw (Madeline) of Relay, MD; a niece; a nephew; a daughter from a previous marriage, Dianna Meushaw; and a granddaughter. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by his brothers, Donald and Dennis Meushaw; and a nephew, Mark Meushaw.

Following cremation, a chapel service will be held at a later date, after the holidays, at the Maryland Eastern Shore Veteran's Cemetery near Hurlock.
