



## Thomas B. Morison

December 20, 1918 - October 1, 2012

Thomas B. Morison, of Easton, MD, formerly of Oxford, MD, died at William Hill Manor Gardens, on October 1, 2012. He was 93.

Mr. Morison was born on December 20, 1918, in Glen Ridge, NJ, to the late, Binnie and Helen Frances Smith Morison. He attended Montclair High School, graduating Class of 1936. He continued his education at Yale University, graduating in 1940. After graduation, he began working at Goodyear International Corporation. He remained with the company for forty years serving various capacities, mainly with their overseas subsidiaries. On November 9, 1946, he married Barbara Doyle. They made their home overseas during his career with Goodyear for 20 years, until coming back to Ohio in 1966. Mr. Morison retired from Goodyear in 1980.

During World War II, Mr. Morison served as a bomber pilot with the 8th Air Force in Europe.

Prior to moving to Oxford, MD in 1981, he and his wife lived in Akron, OH, for 15 years, where he was as member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church. Since moving to Oxford, he has been a member of Christ Church in Easton where he served as a vestry member, junior warden, and on several committees. He is also a member of the St. Andrews Society, Chesapeake Bay Yacht Club, and Friends of the Talbot County Library. He has served as a volunteer at the

Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum and the Annual Waterfowl Festival. He was on the board of Talbot County Historical Society and the Easton Day Care Center, Inc.

Mr. Morison is survived by his wife, Barbara; three children, Evelyn C. Huber, Thomas B. Morison and Andrew G. Morison; six grandchildren, S. Adam Rector, Meredith P. Watson, Brittany D. Morison, Taylor A. Morison, Kaitlyn A. Morison and Anna K. Morison; and a great-grandson, James R. Watson.

He was preceded in death by two sisters, Harriet and Crystal.

A memorial service will be held at Christ Church, 111 S. Harrison St., in Easton on Monday, October 8, 2012 at 11 a.m.

A private inurnment will be held at Oxford Cemetery.
