September 17, 1924 - November 9, 2014

Thomas J. Quinn, Jr., of New Castle, DE, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, November 9, 2014. He was 90.

Mr. Quinn was born on September 17, 1924, in Golts, MD. He was the son of the late Thomas J. Quinn, Sr., and Nellie Moffett Quinn. Upon graduating high school, Mr. Quinn enlisted in the Marines to serve his great country from 1942 to 1945. Mr. Quinn worked on his father's farm until he purchased and operated his own dairy and grain farm in Galena, MD. After selling his farm, Mr. Quinn went to work for Amaco driving a truck for many years and then most recently he worked for MBNA for 5-1/2 years.

After retirement, at age 74, he and his wife, Joan, the delight of his life, purchased a new motor home and did extensive traveling to all the states, but loved Alaska and salmon fishing. He also enjoyed bowling and walking and exercising and spending time with his grandchildren and great grandchildren and watching them grow up. Mr. Quinn was a member of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church in Bear, DE, where he often filled in as Altar Server at Tuesday night mass. He was a 3rd degree Knights of Columbus council #7990, member of Bohemia Historical Society in Warwick, MD, and a lifetime member of the American Legion, VFW, and AARP.

Mr. Quinn is survived by his loving wife of 20 years, Joan Quinn of New

Castle, DE; two sons from a previous marriage, Jay Quinn of Elkton, MD, Dennis Quinn of Washington, DC; two stepdaughters, Denise Casale and family of Plano, TX, and Renee Bailey and family of Newark, DE; nine grandchildren, Thomas, Jay, Melissa, Ashlee, Brittnee, Justin, Taylor, Leah, and Zackery; and four great-grandchildren, Justin, Michael, Caleb, and Bentley.

A visitation will be held on Friday, November 14, 2014, from 9:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church, 345 Bear-Christiana Road in Bear, DE, where a Mass of Christian Burial will begin at 11:00 a.m. Interment will be in St. Dennis Catholic Church Cemetery (Lampson Station) in Galena, MD, at 2:00 p.m.



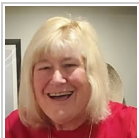
