April 14, 1941 - July 15, 2021

Thomas B. Simmons of Still Pond, MD died on July 15, 2021 at Compass Regional Hospice in Chestertown. He was 80.

He was born on April 14, 1941 in Camden, NJ, the son of the late Thomas B. Sr. and Katherine Pennypacker Simmons and stepson to the late Pauline Simmons.

He was a graduate of Triton High School in NJ. While working at a stable and teaching horseback riding, he met and on February 1, 1962, married Anne Hickman Williams.

They moved from NJ to Still Pond, MD where they owned and operated their farm.

Mr. Simmons hauled hay and straw for a living, livestock for Rudnick's Livestock Auction House, worked as a milktester, drove a school bus, and owned and operated a seed and feed business. He was a fixture at Rudnick's, loved to mow grass, was proud of growing his own tobacco, enjoyed antique tractors and gardening, and was happiest when working.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his daughter: Sally Bitter of Chestertown, MD, his son: Andy Simmons and his wife Donna of Still Pond, MD, grandchildren: Brandon, Daniel (Stephanie), and Ryan (Nevada) Bitter and Nathan and Danielle Simmons, along with his four great grandchildren: Alexandria, Grayson, Bella, and Merritt.
