Thomas Campbell Chidsey, 78, died August 17, 2006 in Chestertown, Maryland, after a courageous battle with brain cancer.

Mr. Chidsey was born in Wayne, Pennsylvania. He was a graduate of Mercersburg Academy and Lehigh University, where he was a member of Chi Phi Fraternity. During World War II, he served in the U. S.
