Thomas Donaldson "T.J." Elgen, Jr. of Oxford, MD, formerly of Solomons Island, died on Friday, August 20, 2004 at University of Maryland Hospital in Baltimore. He was 55.

Born November 15, 1948 in Washington, D.C., he was the son of the late Lt. Commander Thomas Donaldson Elgen and Polly Jenkins Elgen of Easton. He spent his early years living with his family in military bases around the world, including Okinawa, Japan and Morocco. He was a graduate of the University of Maryland, College Park.

While residing in Solomons Island, he was the owner of Creative Contractors, Inc. For several years he was treasurer of the Solomons Island Business Association. He moved to the Easton area in 1994 and became owner of The Sports Section of Delmarva. He received many awards as the owner of that firm, including The President's Club Award, and he held the distinction of being the second largest producing franchise of Sports Sections in the country.

T.J. enjoyed boating, playing the guitar and spending time with family and friends. He was a devoted father who wished to be remembered as someone who respected all living things.

In addition to his mother, T.J. is survived by his wife, Melissa M. Elgen and their four children, Gigi, Johnathan, Summer and Riley, all of Oxford; as well as many cousins.
