



## Thomas D. Royer

Thomas D. "Tommy" Royer, a lifelong resident of Easton, MD died on Tuesday, September 7, 2004 at Genesis Elder Care – The Pines, Easton. He was 86.

Born in Easton on February 2, 1918, he was the son of the late Adam and Laura Smith Royer. After graduating from Easton High School in 1937, he worked various jobs until entering the U.S. Army where he served during World War II. Following his release from active duty, he went to work for Protane, now known as Norgas, where he remained until his retirement in 1980. From 1983 to 1993, he worked part-time for Newnam Funeral Home in Easton and part-time at the Easton Vol. Fire Dept.

His wife, the former Mary Marshall, whom he married in 1952, died in 1986.

A member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, he was also a life member of the Easton Volunteer Fire Dept., where he served as Chaplain and had conducted many school tours of the fire dept., a charter member of E.E. Streets Memorial Post #5118 V.F.W. and a member of American Legion Post #70.

Mr. Royer is survived by a son, David A. Royer and his wife, Regina of Easton; and two grandsons, Jared A. Royer and Michael Richie Royer both of

Easton.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, September 11, 2004 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call on Friday evening from 6 to 8 PM.

Burial with Military and Fire Department honors will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton, MD.
