Thomas E. Chester, beloved uncle of Connie and Vicky Walters, Cindy Alley, Jerome Chester, Jr. and Edward Chester, Jr., died on October 29, 2001 at Anne Arundel Medical Center, Annapolis. He was 66.

Born on June 21, 1935 in Baltimore, he was the son of the late John Szczeszek-Chester and Stella Majewski. He attended school in Baltimore, and enlisted in the U.S. Army in August of 1953. After serving in the Korean Conflict, he returned to Baltimore where he began working for National Brewery as a linesman. In 1967 he moved to the Eastern Shore, where he resided in Stevensville. He continued working for National Brewery until his retirement in 1996. He was a member of the American Legion Post #278, AARP, and Local Union #570. Mr. Chester enjoyed life along the Eastern Shore, crabbing, gardening and quiet time with his family.

Mr. Chester is survived by two sisters, Clara Brooks of Reisterstown and Dorothy Ward of Baltimore; and many nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by four brothers, Richard Szczeszek, John Szczeszek, Jerome Chester, Sr. and Edward Chester, Sr.
