



## Thomas Edwin Somers Sr.

Thomas Edwin Somers, Sr., of Easton, died at the Union Memorial Hospital, Baltimore, on Saturday April 26, 2003. He was 87.

Born in Crisfield, May 29, 1915, he was the son of the late Abraham Nelson and Grace Sterling Somers. After graduating from Crisfield High School, he moved to Baltimore where he began his career in novelty and drug store retail sales and management. During his career, he had worked for McCrory's 5 & 10 and Fox's 5 & 10, Leder Drug Stores and Drug City Pharmacy from which he medically retired in 1974.

As a member of the Maryland National Guard, he was activated for service in the U. S. Army during World War II. He was a member and the first Post Commander of the Govans American Legion Post.

A very active member of the Boundary United Methodist Church in Govans while living in Baltimore, he was also a member of the Eastern Shore Society of Baltimore and Past President of the Methodist Men Social Union . Since moving to Easton in 1983, he had been a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church.

His hobby in retirement was woodworking.

Mr. Somers is survived by his wife, the former Norma W. Kreymer whom he married September 6, 1942 in Baltimore; a son, Thomas E. Somers, Jr. and his wife, Bonnie, of Newcomb and a grandson, Samuel T. Somers.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday, April 30th, at 1 P.M. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to service.

Burial will be at the Maryland Veterans Cemetery-Eastern Shore at Beulah.
