Thomas F. Hoctor of St. Michaels, MD died Wednesday, July 17, 2001 at William Hill Manor, Easton. He was 82.

Born November 22, 1918 in New York City, he was the son of the late Frank M. and Kathryn Quirk Hoctor. A graduate of Townsend Harris High School and College of the City of New York, he took his MA at New York University and an advanced degree in Economics at the University of Michigan. In 1941 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and although he was injured he served to wars end. Following his release from active duty, he was a counselor for the Veterans Administration in New York. In January 1950, he joined the American Foreign Service, serving tours as Resident Officer in Vohen Strauss, Germany, Economic Officer in Bucharest, Romania, Desk Officer in Washington, DC and Economic Officer in Calcutta, India. He retired from the Foreign Service in 1972. Upon his retirement he accepted an Associate Professorship of Economics at the University of Baltimore, retiring as a tenured Professor in the early 1980"s.

A resident of St. Michaels since January 1976, he was a member of Christ Church, St. Michaels and The Disabled American Veterans, Chapter 31, MD.

Mr. Hoctor is survived by his wife of 51 years, the former, Ruth Meyers; a son, Ralph T. Hoctor of Saratoga Springs, NY; two sisters, Joan Farberman of

Easton, MD and Alice Knight of Ormond Beach, Florida; and four grandchildren, Matthew, Margaret, James and Caroline.

Services will be held Wednesday, July 25, 2001 at 11:00 AM at the Md Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery Chapel, Hurlock, MD.
