



## Thomas F. Moore

November 27, 1935 - February 14, 2009

Thomas F. Moore 73, a retired member of the D.C. Metro Police Department, died on February 14th of heart failure at the Washington Hospital Center. He was a resident of Annapolis before moving to Prospect Bay in Grasonville, MD.

Mr. Moore was born and raised in the Bronx, New York and served in the Marine Corps from 1952 to 1955. He was a graduate of American University. He joined the D.C. Metro Police Department in 1959 retiring in 1980 as their Chief Polygraph Examiner. He then owned and operated Polygraph Verification Systems until 1990. He also was a real estate agent with Coldwell Banker in Annapolis until 2000.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Kathleen Moore of Prospect Bay; five children, Thomas Moore of Grasonville, MD, Susan Keen of Odenton, Brian Moore of Lusby, Joanne Moore of Annapolis and John Moore of Ocean City, and four grandchildren; Christopher and Jennifer Keen and Michelle and Kate Moore.
