Thomas James Davis, of Easton, died at Chesapeake Woods Center, Cambridge on Thursday, January 29, 2003. He was 86.

Born near Trappe, May 22, 1917, he was the son of the late Harry H. and Lulu Spencer Davis. After graduating from the Cordova High School in 1934, he joined the U. S. Marine Corps. After his release from active duty in 1938, he, in 1941, was employed by the C. & P. Telephone Company as a manager on the Eastern Shore of Virginia. He was later transferred to Salisbury and then to Easton where he retired in 1978 as a Field Engineer with 37 1/2 years of service.

A member and former Vestryman of Christ Episcopal Church, St. Michaels, he was also a member of the Easton Elks Lodge #1622, The Loyal Order of Moose, Easton Lodge 1520 and a very active member of the Telephone Pioneers of America. His hobbies included crabbing, fishing, boating and gardening.

Mr. Davis is survived by his wife, the former Jeanette Hopkins whom he married in Easton on Nov. 24, 1937; a daughter, Mary Davis Granger of Neavitt ; a son, James M. Davis of Easton; a brother, Edward H. Davis of Cordova and two grandchildren, Jared Davis and Justin Davis. Another brother, Henry H. Davis, a sister, Ellen D. Straughn and a half- sister, Agnes Knotts, are deceased.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, February 2, 2004 at 2:00 PM at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton where friends

may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial, with military honors, will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
