Thomas John "Mack" McCarty of Smyrna, DE died on Tuesday, February 12, 2002 at Kent General Hospital, Dover, DE. He was 96.

Born in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late John & Catherine Davis McCarty.

Mr. McCarty worked for Paradee oil Co. as a mechanic. He was an avid train collector, and at his last count he had over 20 trains, some of which are over fifty years old and early in his collecting career he had owned over 75 trains and equipment. He enjoyed making and creating many of the small pieces used for his display as well as making his own train cars and parts for his sets. He was well known for fixing friends and neighbor's trains to see that they were ready for the holidays. Mr. McCarty loved to fish and enjoyed spending time with people.

He was a member of Betterton United Methodist Church, and was a former member of the Betterton Still Pond Lions Club and the Greensboro Lions Club and currently a member of the Clayton, DE Lions Club.

Mr. McCarty is survived by his wife of 55 years, Christine R. McCarty; a son, James L. McCarty of Smyrna, DE and a brother, William James McCarty of Baltimore, MD; 9 grandchildren and several great grandchildren.

Mr. McCarty was preceded in death by a son, Jack McCarty and a daughter, Catherine M. Smith.

Graveside services will be held on Thursday, February 14, 2002 at 1:00 p.m. in the Still Pond Cemetery, Still Pond, MD.
