Thomas L. "T.L." Reynolds of Easton, formerly of Hillsboro, MD, passed away on Friday, June 30, 2006 at William Hill Manor, Easton. He was 88.

Born in Baltimore, March 18, 1918, he was the son of the late Harry C. and Faith B. Lindsay Reynolds. He was a 1936 graduate of Centreville High School. While working as a wainwright with Glen L. Martin Co. in Middle River, he attended a trade school for heating and plumbing from 1946-1948. He then opened his own business as a heating and plumbing engineer.

A resident of Hillsboro for forty years, he was a life member of the Queen Anne-Hillsboro Vol. Fire Co. and the Queenstown Vol. Fire Co. for seventy years. He was named to the Hall of Fame for the Maryland State Firemen's Association, the Delmarva Firemen's Association and Talbot County Fire and Rescue. He served as President of the Kent-Queen Anne's Firemen's Association from 1963-1964 and in 1971 served as President of the Maryland State Firemen's Association. He was also a member of the Kent Coin Club.

Mr. Reynolds is survived by his wife, Eleanor Reynolds, whom he married in Centreville, MD on January 1, 1942; his daughter, Diane Baynard and her husband Sherman of Centreville; a brother, James E. Reynolds and his wife Ruth; a sister, Mary Lu McBurney; and two grandchildren, Tracy Baynard and her husband Bo Fernhall, and Kristie Baynard.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, July 11, 2006 at 11:00 AM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Centreville, MD. Friends may call at the funeral home in Centreville on Monday evening, July 10, 2006 from 6 to 8 PM.

Burial will be at Greenmount Cemetery, Hillsboro, MD.
