



## Thomas Lange Capt. U.S.N. Ret. Dwyer

Captain Thomas Lange Dwyer, USN, Ret. died Friday, May 11, 2001 at his home in St. Michaels. He was 78.

Born September 6, 1922, he was the son of the late Thomas Bernard and Elsie Lange Dwyer of Glens Falls, New York.

A graduate of Columbia University, he joined the Navy in April 1942. During World War II he served as Assistant Gunnery Officer aboard the USS Hugh W. Hadley, which was awarded a Presidential Unit Citation for its part in the invasion of Okinawa. Among other highlights of Capt. Dwyer's thirty-two year career in the Navy included serving as Assistant Naval Attache at the American Embassy in Paris, France and as Executive Assistant and Senior Aide to two Commanders-in Chief Pacific, Admiral John S. McCain Jr. and Admiral Noel Gayler.

Following his retirement in 1974, Capt. Dwyer and his wife, the former Marie-Therese Larue of New Orleans whom he married in 1974, remained in Hawaii until 1986, when they moved to St. Michaels. He was a member and former President of the Talbot Country Club and served on the St. Michaels Board of Appeals.

In addition to his wife, Capt. Dwyer is survived by a son, Thomas M. Dwyer of

Agana, Guam; two daughters, Deidre D. Dessommes of Arlington, VA and Maeve D. Greiner of Ruskin, FL; one granddaughter, Jade D. Quick of St. Petersburg, FL; one great grandson, Connor Quick; a sister, Joan D. Doyle of Glen Falls; and three brothers, Robert H. Dwyer of North Point, FL, Edward F. Dwyer of Punta Gorda, FL, and David W. Dwyer of Athens, GA. He was predeceased by a son, Sean P. Dwyer, who died in 1999.

A memorial service will be held at St. Michaels Catholic Chapel on Thursday, May 17, 2001 at 11:30 AM.

A graveside service with full military honors will be held at the Arlington National Cemetery Columbarium, Arlington, VA, Thursday, May 31 at 3 PM.
