Thomas Michael Cavanaugh of St. Michaels, MD died on Tuesday, April 5, 2005 at the Genesis Eldercare-The Pines, Easton, MD. He was 67.

Born on September 20, 1937 in Tacoma Park, MD, he was the son of the late Maurice F. and Frances Brady Cavanaugh. He grew up in Washington D.C. and was a graduate of Gonzaga High School. After attending Georgetown University and Strayers College in Washington DC, he began a career with Woodworth & Lothrop, Inc in the operations department where he met and married his wife of 37 years Audrey R. Sokol on March 3, 1968. They resided in Oxon Hill, MD as Mr. Cavanaugh worked for the Federal Government with GSA (General Services Administration) and with the U.S. Patent Office as a systems analyst, retiring in 1994 and moving to St. Michaels, MD in March of 1998.

Mr. Cavanaugh was a devoted volunteer for 37 years with the Coast Guard Auxiliary serving on all levels; in Flotilla 45; Divisional; 5th District and National. He was very fond of his specialty, new member training. He also served as a docent at the Maritime Museum in St. Michael's and was just shy of achieving his 1000 hrs of service. He was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church.

He is survived by his wife Audrey R. Cavanaugh of St. Michael's, MD; a sister,

Kathleen Sylvain and her husband Robert of Haines City, FL; two nieces, Donna Sylvain and Dolores Demich; a nephew, Mark Sylvain; one great niece & nephew Michelle & Christopher Sylvain.

A memorial mass will be held on Monday, April 11, 2005 at 11:00 AM at the St. Michaels Chapel in St. Michaels, MD. A private interment will take place in Cedar Hill Cemetery in MD.
