Thomas Michael “Mike” Lister, of Cordova, died at the Memorial Hospital at Easton on Saturday, September 14, 2002. He was 54.

Born in Easton, October 22, 1947, he was the son of Betty Conley Lister of Ruthsburg and the late Willard “Tit” Lister. After graduating from Easton High School in 1966, he enlisted in the U. S. Air Force. Following his release from active duty in 1970, he farmed and drove a milk truck for Clark Brothers. At the time of his death, he was employed by Towers Concrete Company in Denton where he had worked for 10 years.

His hobbies included running his dogs and riding horses. His former memberships included the Eastern Shore Jousting Association and the Jolly Circle Horse Club.

Surviving, in addition to his mother, are his wife, the former Donna Jo States whom he married July 8, 1983; two sons, Daniel L Lister of Cordova, a Senior at Easton High School and Michael A. Lister and his wife, Brenda and her daughter, Stacey O’Donnell of Queenstown; two sisters, Debbie L. Harris and Linda L. Spencer, both of Ruthsburg; two brothers, Willard T. “Tippy” Lister of Easton and Richard C. “Ricky” Lister of Cordova; four nephews, Mark Harris of Easton, Stephen Harris of Centreville, Will Lister and Craig Lister, both of Easton; two nieces, Amy Spencer of Ridgely and Beth Lister of Easton and

two great nieces, Allison Harris of Centreville and Bailey Harris of Easton as well as several aunts and uncles. A brother, James "Ikey" Lister is deceased.
