



## Thomas N. Ingerson

January 1, 1918 - December 14, 2008

Thomas Nelson Ingerson of Easton, MD died Sunday, Dec. 14, 2008 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton.

Born January 1, 1918, the son of Walter C. and Alice G. Hills Ingerson of Providence, Rhode Island, Mr. Ingerson received a degree in Chemical Engineering from Cornell University in 1940. He married Ruth Alexander of Matthews, North Carolina in 1952. Mr. Ingerson worked for many years for FMC Corporation, and retired in 1979 as manager of the company's plant in Curtis Bay, Maryland.

Mr. Ingerson always enjoyed exploring and the outdoors. In his younger days he traversed the Adirondacks by canoe from Old Forge to Saranac Lake in New York State. In retirement, Mr. and Mrs. Ingerson spent time together "gunkholing" the Chesapeake and its tributaries in their sailboat; participating in Elderhostel programs around the country; and taking coastal and canal cruises in the United States and abroad.

Mr. Ingerson had a lifelong commitment to community service, volunteering as a scoutmaster with the Boy Scouts of America, and with his wife, for the Talbot County Library and many other organizations. Mr. Ingerson also served several terms as president of the Board of Directors of the Londonderry Retirement Community.

Mr. Ingerson is survived by his wife Ruth Alexander Ingerson; and by his children and grandchildren: Alice E. Ingerson of Massachusetts, with her children Ezra and Hannah Weller; Ann L. Ingerson of Vermont; Helen G. Ingerson of California; and Gordon T. Ingerson of Baltimore, with his children Meagan and Sarah Ingerson.

Burial will be in the Ingerson family plot in the North Burial Ground in Providence, Rhode Island, at a later date.
