Thomas Whitmore Blakslee of Centreville, MD died Friday, January 7, 2005 at his home. He was 80.

Born on February 27, 1924 in Ehrenfeld, PA he was the son of the late, Samuel Whitmore and Frances Eberly Blakslee. He attended school in Pennsylvania and in Cecil County, MD and graduated from the Pennsylvania Military Academy. After graduation he served in the U.S. Army in the northern Atlantic during WW II. When he returned from the Army he moved to Centreville, MD where he worked on the family farm at Walnut Grove. He also worked as an inspector for the State Road Commission and later worked for the Quimby Family on their farm and a paper delivery business. His last employment was with the Downs Music Company in Centreville, MD.

He attended Mother of Sorrows Catholic Church in Centreville, MD and was a member of the American Legion Jeff Davis Post #18 in Centreville, MD. He was an avid sports fan, particularly the Orioles and Ravens. He could be seen almost daily walking in Centreville with his newspaper under one arm and pipe in his mouth.

Mr. Blakslee was predeceased by his wife, Agnes Hadley Blakslee (1956;) his son, Thomas Whitmore Blakslee, Jr. (1989) and his twin sister, Jane Wright (1994). He is survived by one, niece Geri W. Whitby and two nephews,

Thomas C. Wright and Stephen B. Wright, all of Centreville, MD; one great niece; two great nephews, and one great great niece and nephew.

Funeral services will be held 11AM on Wednesday January 12, 2005 at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam in Centreville, MD where family and friends may call on Tuesday January 11, 2005 form 6PM to 8PM.

Interment will be private.
