



## Thomas William Carpenter

Thomas William Carpenter, of Easton, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Friday, April 6, 2001. He was 64.

Born in Easton, April 27, 1936, he was the son of the late Ollie and Pearl Andrews Carpenter. After attending public school, he worked in the Easton Furniture Factory before becoming a commercial waterman and hunting guide, a career in which he remained active until his death.

A lifelong resident of Easton, Mr. Carpenter or "Bill" as he was best-known, was a member of the Talbot Rod and Gun Club and a former member of the Loyal Order of The Moose, Easton Lodge #1520.

His 1954 marriage to the former Jean Kistler ended in divorce in 1974 and his 1975 marriage to the former Susan Lewis ended in a 1998 divorce.

Mr. Carpenter is survived by seven children, Karen J. Saunders of Owings Mills, William T. Carpenter of Oxford, Kenneth L. Carpenter and Lynn D. Fuller, both of Easton, Timothy L. Carpenter of Cordova, Biff B. Carpenter of Preston and Margaret S. Carpenter of McDaniel; a sister, Marion C. Miller of Easton; eight grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
