Thomas W. Miller was born in Brooklyn, New York on August 18, 1935 to Charlotte and John Miller. Tom died on Saturday, May 30 at age 73.

Tom received an associate degree from Brooklyn College, a B.S. from N.Y.U. and attended an Executive Program at Tuck School, Dartmouth College. Tom worked for Citicorp for 40 years before retiring as a vice president. Some of his responsibilities included serving as a Business Manager for all business in Queens County, New York. Additionally Tom was Executive Vice President and President of the Traveler's Check Business. He also served as Chief-of-Staff to the President of Citicorp and Financial Comptroller of the Individual Bank Division. Tom was a director of Citibank, Florida, based in Miami.

Tom was the loving husband of his wife, Patricia who were married April 1981. They moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland in 1991 where they have lived for the past 18 years, spending winters in Punta Gorda, Florida.

Tom was on the original Board of Directors of Talbot County Habitat for Humanity and served as Director of Development and Financial Treasurer. He also was founding member of Talbot Mentors. Tom served as a docent at the Chesapeake Maritime Museum and was a volunteer at Easton Memorial Hospital.

Tom was a member of St. Luke's United Methodist Church in St. Michaels,

Maryland where he served on the Finance Committee, the Permanent Endowment Committee and the Staff Parish Relations Committee.

Tom was predeceased by his daughter, Catherine Chernega and he is survived by his daughter, Christine Konsistorum and son-in-law, Steve of Albany, New York; his brother, Bruce and his wife, Rita of Arizona and his sister-in-law Marie Dempsey and her husband, John of Cordova, Maryland.
