



Tilden M. Higgs

November 24, 1922 - September 11, 2012

Tilden M. Higgs of Chestertown, MD, died on Tuesday September 11, 2012, in the Hospice of Queen Anne's, Centreville, MD. He was 89.

Mr. Higgs was born in Harrisonburg, VA, the son of the late Davis and Grace Higgs. Mr. Higgs worked as a Steamfitter/Plumber for many years, working for the United States Department of Agriculture. Mr. Higgs was a United States naval veteran, serving in both WWII and Korea, and much of his time was served onboard the 2200ton Destroyer USS Brush.

Mr. Higgs attended Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Chestertown, MD, and was a third degree member of the Knights of Columbus Council 2809 in Hyattsville, MD. He was also a member of the Frank Jarman American Legion Post #36, Chestertown, MD. Mr. Higgs loved to pitch horseshoes and go camping. He enjoyed his home in Duck Neck campground and all the friends that came there throughout the years. He was also known as an avid crabber, enjoying the catch from the river and bay.

Mr. Higgs is preceded in death by his wife, Anna H. Higgs in 1993; as well as a brother Harry Lee Higgs; and a sister Maude Bishop. He is survived by four sons, Peter M. Higgs and his wife of Jessup, MD, William T. Higgs, and Thomas P. Higgs, both of Landover, MD, and Steven A. Higgs of Millington, MD; five grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.

Prayers will be offered on Monday September 17, 2012, at 11 a.m. in the Fellows Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, 370 W. Cypress St., Millington, MD. Friends and family may call after 10 a.m. Interment will be held in the Crumpton Cemetery with military honors.

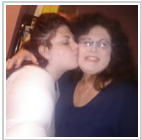

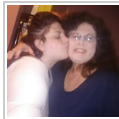
