Tilghman William Timms of Grasonville died on Friday, November 7, 2008 at Genesis Eldercare – The Pines in Easton. He was 86 years old.

Tilghman W. Timms was born on March 15, 1922 in Chester, MD to the late Frank Timms and Elizabeth Hampton. He began his career working on the water at a young age.
