Timothy Greenfield DeMoss, born April 1, 1984, died suddenly on March 30, 2014, as a result of a motorcycle accident. Tim was a resident of Los Angeles, CA.

Tim was born and raised on Maryland's Eastern Shore in Queen Annes County. He attended Sudlersville Elementary. When the family moved to Morgantown, WV, Tim continued his education at South Middle School. He graduated from Morgantown High School in 2002. After high school, Tim attended Wyotech Technical School in Pennsylvania. He graduated in 2004.

Tim moved to Los Angeles in 2005. From that moment on, Tim felt at home. He perfected his welding skills, designing staircases, fences, furniture and a myriad of other projects. His passion, however, was re-fabricating motorcycles. He had the skill to turn an old, unused bike into something attractive and usable. Tim's naturally creative mind never stopped designing yet an even better bike.

Tim never met a stranger. He made friends easily and genuinely enjoyed helping others. His laid back personality was infectious. To all who knew and loved him, Tim was a true friend.

Tim has left behind a large family of friends in Los Angeles who impacted him

greatly. In particular, his two buddies, Wendel Aguilar and James Laub who will continue Tim's work in the shop. Tim will also be missed by his American Bull dog, Henry, his constant companion.

Tim is survived by his parents, Jeff DeMoss of Painter, VA, his mother, Mary Currier, of Newport RI; and his sisters, Cassy DeMoss also of Newport and Alison Henry ,and husband Michael, of Exmore VA.

In Tim's memory, we ask that you donate to your local SPCA in order that dogs, such as his beloved Henry, might find a good home.

A funeral service will be held at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Centreville, MD, where friends and family may visit on Monday, April 7, from 5-7 p.m.

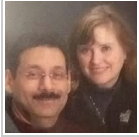
