Timothy Hartnett of Easton passed away peacefully at home on Nov 9, 2023, after battling metastatic prostate cancer for 18 months. He was just shy of his 82nd birthday.

Tim was born and raised in NYC. He joined the NYPD in 1967 and enjoyed a 34-year career, retiring as a 1st Grade Homicide Detective. His young grandson attended the last promotion ceremony and was confused as to why we were all so proud of Tim, given the fact that 1st graders were normally 5 years old.

Tim and Jean were married in 1987. Their platonic relationship morphed into a love story lasting 36 years. The blended family of 4 boys and 1 girl quickly became a whole unit. Nine grandchildren arrived over the years. Love and laughter cemented the "joining".

Tim acquired many titles throughout his life: Husband, Dad, Stepdad, In-Law, Detective, Friend, Chief, Honey, Mr. Wonderful, Putz...but his favorite was PopPop. The latest addition to the family arrived in January 2022: twins Delilah and Luca, thereby making him a great-grandfather. He adored those babies, and they provided the source of his last big smile here on earth. The twins will hear all the PopPop stories over the years and realize that they missed knowing a wonderful man.
