Timothy John Kern of Chestertown, MD died September 2, 2006 from injuries sustained in a jet ski accident. He was 23 years old.

Born in Woodbury, New Jersey on March 18, 1983, he was the son of Michael Joseph and Lori Janda Kern of Chestertown, Maryland.

Tim was a 2002 graduate of Kent County High School where he earned 11 Varsity Letters, won the coach's award in 2001 in Football, and served as Captain of the Varsity Lacrosse team in both his junior and senior years. Tim was currently enrolled at the University of Maryland where he was completing his last semester of his senior year toward a Bachelor of Science Degree in American Studies.

At the University of Maryland he competed in club lacrosse and was a member of Phi Delta Theta fraternity. In addition to just about any sport, Tim enjoyed snow skiing, wake boarding, running, football, and especially his first love, lacrosse. He was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Chestertown, Maryland and worked in the summer months at Washington College in the Athletic Department.

In addition to his parents he is survived by a brother, Andrew Michael Kern of Chestertown, Maryland, his paternal grandmother Jeanette Kern of

Monroeville, New Jersey and his maternal grandfather John Janda of Naples, Florida, along with many loving aunts, uncles, and cousins. He was the grandson of the late Walter J. Kern of Monroeville, New Jersey.
