



## Timothy "Tim" Paul Whitfield

January 19, 1959 - December 16, 2020

Timothy "Tim" Paul Whitfield of Frederick, MD died Wednesday December 16, 2020 peacefully at his home. He was 61.

Born January 19, 1959 in Hyattsville MD, Tim was the son of Leon and the late Kate Whitfield. He graduated from DeMatha Catholic High School in Hyattsville, MD in 1977 and then stayed active in the local Prince George's County community. Tim eventually went on to work for the United States Postal Service, to which he dedicated over 30 years of service. Tim lived a loving and vibrant life with his partner Dean. He enjoyed vacationing to the beach with family and spending time with friends.

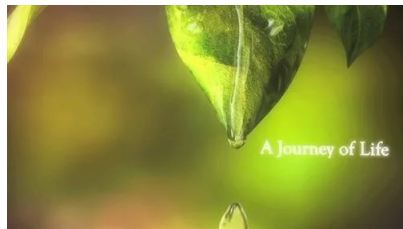

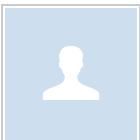
