



## Timothy E. Dills

Timothy E. Dills of Trappe died peacefully at his home Saturday, February 25, 2006, after a twelve-year battle with melanoma cancer. He was 63.

He was a real estate developer and entrepreneur by nature. He believed in Easton and was a visionary for its development. Timothy received an Award for Excellence from the Maryland State Planning Commission for his contributions to Victoria Walk, “a project which fosters a strong sense of community through planning and design.” Always pushing the envelope, his local endeavors included TalbotTown Shopping Center, the West Street Office Buildings, and Tree Haven town homes. Always generous, he was a fervent supporter of many local charities.

A lover of music and the Arts, Timothy had an extensive art collection and believed that supporting the Arts was good business. He patronized many local art galleries and local artists and helped to make Easton’s first Plein Air Art Festival and Competition a reality by donating funds toward the event’s premier year in 2005.

Passionate and strong willed, Timothy Dills was a world traveler and explorer. He crossed the Atlantic Ocean by boat twice, once sailing single-handedly for 19 days 4 hours and 20 minutes.

Timothy Dills is survived by his wife and friend Ellen Vatne General, Executive Director of the Avalon Foundation. A gathering in his memory will be held privately.
