



T. Nicholas Crump, Sr.

September 16, 1938 - February 26, 2010

T. Nicholas Crump, Sr. of Queenstown, MD died at his home the morning of February 26, 2010 after battling pancreatic cancer with his wife and daughter at his bedside. He was 71.

Born September 16, 1938 in Richmond, VA the son of the late, J. Taylor Ellyson Crump and Elizabeth Willingham Crump, grandson of Martha Landstreet Willingham and Nancy Ellyson Crump, the 3rd great grandson of Andrew Johnson, 17th president of the United States. Nick attended St. Christopher School and Augusta Military Academy in VA. He served honorably in the US Navy. On August 3, 1969 he married Renee Ouellette. Nick was employed with Galeski Photo Ctr as supervisor of stores and corporate coordinator. He also owned his own wholesale distribution corporation until 1976, when he joined the E.A. Holsten Company as a sales representative and then became vice president of sales. After 16 years the Jenn Air Corporation changed to nationwide distribution and he joined that firm. In 1993 he and wife Renee relocated from Bon Air, VA to Queenstown, MD and worked as senior loan officer until his retirement in 2003 due to health problems.

Nick enjoyed his home on the Eastern Shore, his loving wife, Sunday Brunch at Riordans & McGarvey's and some very special friends.

He is survived by his wife of 40 years Renee Ouellette; a daughter, Kevin Holder; grandsons, Taylor N. Crump III, David and Ryan Crump, Jason Holder and great grandchildren, Christa Sue and Christopher Holder.
