



## Tobin E. Price Sr.

July 25, 1925 - December 4, 2013

Tobin E. Price, Sr., 88, of Stevensville, MD, died on December 4, 2013, at the Queen Anne's County Hospice Center.

Mr. Price was born on July 25, 1925, in Wilmington, DE, to the late Seth A. Price and Ola E. Price. He attended Galena High School, graduating in the Class of 1943. He then entered the U.S. Navy in 1943, and was honorably discharged in 1946.

On July 4, 1947, he married H. Louise Rowan, and the couple resided in Massey, MD. Mr. Price began working with Choptank Electric, and later worked for Delmarva Power, from which he retired in 1988 as a supervisor overseeing the linemen. In 1970, the Price family moved to Kent Island.

Mr. Price is a life member of the American Legion and VFW. He is a past member of the Lions Club.

He is survived by his loving wife, H. Louise Price; their four children, Margo L. Price, Tobin E. Price, Jr., John A. Price and Clark T. Price; seven grandchildren, Brian Jordan, Cassidy Price, Claire Price, Emily G. Price, Emily L. Price, Jaret Price, and Anna M. Price; and his siblings, Robert Price, Helen Palmatory, Wolford Palmatory, and Rolland Price. He was predeceased by his siblings, James Price and Anna Lindsay.
