Tony Harned of Denton died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton on Tuesday, July 16, 2002. He was 51.

Born April 3, 1951 in Ft. Lee, Virginia, he was the son of Eleanor Franklin Harned of New Port Richey, FL and the late Johnny Miles Harned. Mr. Harned received a BA Degree from the University of Maryland and in 1973 he married his high school sweetheart, E. Anne MacDaniel and they resided in Arbutus, MD where he worked for ACME.
