Tracy Lynn Kennedy of Sudlersville, MD, died Friday December 12, 2014, in her home after a long illness. She was 51 years old.

Tracy was the daughter of Marian Bratcher Kennedy of Sudlersville, MD, and the late Howard Randolph Kennedy. Tracy worked as a daycare teacher until her illness forced her to retire.

In addition to her mother, she is survived by her son, Joshua Freeman; her brother, Howard Kennedy; and a sister, Lisa Kennedy. Many extended family members also survive her.

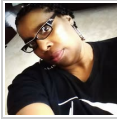
