November 3, 1974 - February 18, 2009

Tricia Jill Quillen of Crumpton, MD died on February 18, 2009 at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, MD. She was 34.

Born on November 3, 1974 she was the daughter of the late David Owen Mench and Deborah (Bryden) Cain of Rock Hall, MD. Tricia was a 1992 graduate of Kent County High. She spent one year of studies at Chesapeake College, then spent three years at McQueen-Gibbs in Easton, MD, and continued at University of Delaware earning her BSN Degree. After college Tricia worked as a Registered Nurse at Chester River Hospital Center. She was a member of the American Legion and Raum Chapel Church in Rock Hall. 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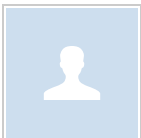
