



## Troy Edwin Barricklow

September 28, 1949 - October 23, 2014

Troy Edwin Barricklow died on October 23, 2014, surrounded by his family in Queenstown, MD. He was 65.

Born on September 28, 1949, in Long Beach, CA, to the late Robert Barricklow and LouEllen Jorgenssen, he grew up in Satellite Beach, FL. After graduating from Satellite Beach High School, Troy joined the U.S Navy where he would serve 27 years becoming a career Naval Officer. He served in VP, VQ and VC Communities being stationed in Jacksonville, FL; Orlando, FL; Guantanamo Bay; Cuba; Rota; Spain; and Patuxent River, MD. He worked as a Naval Aviation Maintenance Officer for most of his career as well as, mentoring and pushing new "recruits" through Navy boot camp.

After retiring, he began working for CACI Technologies for two years then converted to the Federal Government as a Navy Civilian for ten additional years. He worked on the EP3 Team, F18 Team, and the Presidential Helicopter and Foreign Military Sales until retiring in 2012.

Troy enjoyed spending time with his family, traveling in his RV, woodworking, and visiting any beach. Troy was a dedicated and proud American who never thought his role as an active duty member, contractor, or Navy civilian was a job. It was a passion and a gift to serve his country. His favorite quote was "I love God, family and my country!" And he lived his life dedicated to the

meaning of this quote. He will forever be saluted!

He is survived by his wife, Jean D. Barricklow of King George, VA; son, Troy Barricklow II (Shannon) of Queenstown, MD; daughters, Jennifer Wilmoth (Wayne) of King George, VA; Khristy Cole (Justin) of Andrews Air Force Base, MD; brothers, Robert Barricklow (Sue) of Gilbert, AL; Darrell Barricklow (Kelly) of Roseville, CA; seven grandchildren, Rylee Hinshaw, Justin Cole, Jackson Cole, Karleigh Wilmoth, Troy Barricklow III, Avery Barricklow, and Kade Wilmoth.
