Grace Tunis Green Wilson of Tunis Mills, Easton, MD died at Chesapeake Woods Center, Cambridge, MD on Sunday, March 10, 2002. She was 91.

Born in Elizabeth City, North Carolina, May 13, 1910, she was the eldest of five daughters of the late William Howard and May Tunis Green. Four years later the family moved to Rolles Range, St. Michaels and then to Riverside Farm, where she grew up. After graduating from St. Michaels High School, she attended the Maryland Institute of Art in Baltimore. In 1932, she married George H. Wilson, Sr., a Talbot County Farmer and log canoe sailor. They moved to Knightly Point farm near Tunis Mills where they raised a family of four sons and one daughter.

Mrs. Wilson had many interests, however, the Chesapeake Bay log canoes that had been in her father's family and her husband's log canoe "Magic" were a good part of her life. She was courted by her husband in the "Magic". The year after they were married the "Magic" was sent to the New York Boat Show. The log canoe has won the coveted Governor's Cup many times. She was also fond of flowers, children and visiting. Mr. Wilson died in 1969.

Mrs. Wilson is survived by four sons, George H. Wilson, Jr. of Trappe, MD, Henry T. Wilson and Frederick S. Wilson, both of Easton, MD and James H. Wilson of St. Michaels, MD; two sisters, Mildred G. Buchholz of Occacobie, FL

and Eleanor T. Banks, of Easton; fourteen grandchildren and fifteen great grandchildren. A daughter, Jane Rider Wilson Schelhouse died in 1973.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, March 15, 2002 at 11:00 AM at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton, MD.
