Van Gasken Clark, Jr. died on Sunday, July 17, 2005 at his home in Centreville, MD. He was 79.

Born December 18, 1925 in Centreville, he was the son of the late Van Gasken, Sr. and Marjorie Hollingsworth Clark. He was a 1944 graduate of Church Hill High School. On December 27, 1952 he married the former Betty Rollison and they made their home in Church Hill. They later moved to Baltimore and back to Centreville in 1973. From 1957 until retiring in 1988, he was employed by the Maryland Department of Transportation. After retirement, he worked for Bramble Construction Co. until 1992.

A member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, he was also a member of the Queen Anne's County Sportsman's Club, Past President of the Church Hill Alumni Association, a former member of the Church Hill Vol. Fire Co., Past President of the Queen Anne's County Election Board and regional campaign coordinator for Governor Harry Hughes in 1978.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Clark is survived by his daughter, Lisa C. Walls, and her husband Dennis; a son, Van "Chopper" Clark III; granddaughter, Taylor L. Walls; and a sister, Ann Legates all of Centreville. He was affectionately known as "Pop-Pop" Clark by Michael Layton, Andrew Layton, Kelly Shannon, Diana Albers, Brian Morris and Kimberly Morris. He was predeceased by a

sister, Jean Skinner.
