Varnon Eugene "Bunsy" Haddaway, Jr. of Chester, MD died Wednesday, May 5, 2004 at his home. He was 75.

Born on May 21, 1928 in Sherwood, MD, he was the son of the late Varnon Eugene and Alice Wrightson Haddaway. He was a graduate of St. Michaels High School, class of 1945. He worked for Chesapeake Bay Ferry System at Matapeake as First Officer until they tied up. He married the former, Mildred Nash on May 20, 1950 and they resided in Chester. In 1952 he was drafted into the U.S. Army and served in the Korean War from 1952 until 1954. When he returned, he worked as a corrections officer at Old Point until it moved to Church Hill and then he worked as a Waterman and retired in 1995. He enjoyed spending time with his family, harvesting his tomato plants each season and watching old war movies and westerns.

In addition to his wife Mildred, he is survived by two children, Bonny H. Morris(Marvin) and Brett E. Haddaway(Ann) of Chester; three grandchildren, Katie Cole, Brett E. Haddaway, Jr. and Brice E. Haddaway of Chester; one step-grandchild, Katie Morris and a sister, Mary Jane Fairbank of Sherwood, MD.
