Vera Ann Williams of Queenstown, MD, formerly of Chestertown, died on October 31 at Anne Arundel Medical Center.

Born on January 18, 1933, in Kent County, MD, she grew up in Chestertown the daughter of the late George William Townsend and Addie Frances Fithian. She would graduate from Nursing School in Washington, DC, where she was a registered nurse working at George Washington Hospital. She married her husband and moved to North Carolina, where she worked for the Baptist Hospital in the operating room. In the early 1970s, she returned to Chestertown where she continued to work in nursing, providing private duty nursing care. In 1974, she married George S. Williams, to whom she was married for 37 years. Later, she worked for Heron Point, from which she retired in 1994.

Ann enjoyed traveling, especially supporting family events throughout the years, as well as the time spent with her family and grandchildren. Her pastimes included dancing, shuffleboard, crocheting, knitting, gardening and collecting owls. As a child, Ann attended the First United Methodist Church in Chestertown and, after moving to Wye Mills later in life, regularly attended church services in Easton.
