



Vera Taylor Crotsley

August 29, 1932 - March 24, 2017

Vera Taylor Crotsley, formerly of Easton, MD, passed away on Friday, March 24, 2017, at Talbot Hospice in Easton. She was 84.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on August 29, 1932, she was the daughter of the late John Edward and Anna Barbra Feric Taylor. Vera graduated from Patterson Park High School, Class of February 1951. She then attended Maryland Institute of Art and Baltimore Community College.

On July 20, 1952, she married Richard Raymond Crotsley, also of Baltimore, MD. In 1961, they moved to Easton, and she began working for the Talbot County Schools system as an art teacher. In addition, she owned and operated Vera C. Creations both of Easton and Oxford, MD. She was an artist in the Waterfowl Festival in Easton and was one of the organization founders in 1971. In 2004, they moved to Ocean Pines, MD. Vera was a member of the Highland Eastern Star, was Honored Queen of Jobs Daughters, a member of the American Legion Post #166, the Art League in Ocean City, MD, and also a member of both, the Women's Club and Garden Club of Ocean Pines, MD.

Vera is survived by her husband of 64 years, Richard Crotsley, two children, Mark Bradford Crotsley of Skandia, MI, and Valerie Jon Haddaway of Easton; three grandchildren, Mark Bradford Crotsley, Jr., of Aviono, Italy, Eric Taylor Crotsley of Mustang, OK, and Megan Higgins of Sherwood, MD; and four

great-granddaughters.

In addition to her parents, Vera is preceded in death by a son, Richard Brian Crotsley.

A funeral service will be held on Thursday, March 30, 2017, at 11 a.m. at Christ Church, 111 Harrison St, Easton, MD 21601. Burial to follow at Oxford Cemetery.
