Vera S. Hill of Easton, MD died on Thursday, September 2, 2004 at Memorial Hospital at Easton, after a long courageous battle with leukemia. She was 61.

Born in Easton, September 24, 1942, she was the daughter of the late Irvin F., Jr. and Betty R. Jones Smith. A 1960 graduate of Easton High School, she attended Towson University for one year. She worked for a number of years at Rowens Stationary in Easton. From January 1982 until retiring in May of 2001, she was associated with William Hill Manor as the Activities Director.

A lifelong resident of Easton, she was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church and the Talbot Country Club. She loved being with her family, going to the beach, visiting Disney World, playing golf, and her flower gardens. A creative decorator, she was known for her love of Christmas, and had won numerous first place prizes for window decorations at the time of the Waterfowl Festival.

Mrs. Hill is survived by her husband, William C.
