



## Vernice Hoxter

July 10, 1916 - February 15, 2016

Vernice Hoxter of Stevensville, MD, died Monday February 15, 2016, at home. She was 99.

Born on July 10, 1916, in Stevensville, MD, she was the daughter of late Joseph O. Hoxter and Josephine Cole. She was a 1939 graduate of Stevensville High School. After high school, she began working at the perfect garment factory in Grasonville, MD. In 1953, she began working for the Wm Preston Lane Memorial Bridge as a toll collector and retired as a Toll Sergeant in 1978.

Vernice was a member of Christ Episcopal Church in Stevensville, MD, and the Kent Island Volunteer Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary.

She is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, Craig and Luanne Smith of Stevensville; granddaughter, Stephanie Smith of Stevensville; three great-grandchildren, Cassidy and Chelsea Smith and T.J. Gardner; and three great-great grandchildren, Kyara, Elijah, and Izaiah.

She is preceded in death by two brothers, J. Hughley Hoxter and Archie C. Hoxter; two sisters, Edna E. Hoxter and Gladys Hoxter; and nephew, Charles Hoxter.
