



Vernon Olin Handel

October 11, 1917 - September 8, 2011

Vernon Olin Handel of Centreville, MD died on Thursday, September 8, 2011 surrounded by his loving family at Chester River Hospital. He was 93 years old.

Mr. Handel was born on October 11, 1917 in Baltimore, MD to the late, John Handel and Clara B. Weimiester. He grew up in Baltimore and worked for the Koppers Company as a machinist for 45 years. He married Mary Irene Grap on April 27, 1940 and they made their home in Baltimore. They moved to Grasonville in 1961 then to Centreville in 1993. Mrs. Handel died on November 7, 2007. He enjoyed crabbing, fishing, bowling, Bingo and playing horseshoes.

A funeral service will be held at 12:00 noon on Monday, September 12, 2011

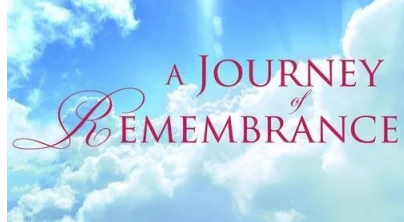
