August 24, 1949 - December 5, 2013

Vicki Lee McPeters died of complications from surgery at Anne Arundel Medical Center on December 5, 2013. She was 64.

Mrs. McPeters was born in Long Beach, CA, the daughter of the late Walter and Margarite Brink. She lived in Walla Walla, WA; Sioux City, IA; Spring Church, PA; and Bladensburg, MD, where she graduated high school.

Mrs. McPeters worked at Goddard Space Flight Center where she met her husband. They moved to Kent Island where she worked at District Photo and with the Girl Scouts of Chesapeake Bay until 2006.
