



Victoria Salvetti Brownley

December 20, 1957 - October 9, 2025

Victoria “Vikki” Brownley (née Salvetti), 67, passed away on October 9, 2025, in Annapolis, Maryland, after facing complications from lung cancer. A vibrant and unforgettable presence, Vikki lived her life with passion, humor, and the unmistakable spirit of a true “Jersey girl.”

Born on December 20, 1957, in New Brunswick, New Jersey, Vikki was the daughter of Nick and Catherine Salvetti, and the oldest of three children. She grew up in Freehold and graduated from Freehold Borough High School with the class of 1976. In 1978, she met and a few short months later married the love of her life, Ron, a recent graduate of the United States Naval Academy.

For 46 years, Vikki shared a devoted marriage with Ron, first as a Navy wife at various duty stations across the country and then ultimately settling with him in the Kent Island area. Together, they built a loving family and created a home filled with laughter, warmth, and spirited conversation. In addition to Ron, Vikki is survived by two daughters: Holly (Matt) and Olivia (Ari), two grandchildren, Alexis and Calvin, her younger brother, Frank (Sue), and numerous nieces and nephews. Her family was the center of her world, and she embraced her roles as sister, wife, mother, aunt, and grandmother with fierce love and unwavering dedication.

She was predeceased by her parents Nick and Catherine Salvetti, and by her

little brother, Richard. Their memories remained close to her heart.

Vikki's personality lit up every room she entered. Known for her quick wit and boundless energy, she became a beloved fixture on the local trivia circuit—especially at The Jetty and Pourhouse Pub—where her sharp mind and competitive spirit made her both a formidable opponent and a cherished teammate. A longtime member of her local book club, she relished lively discussions over novels just as much as she enjoyed sharing news and anecdotes with family and friends. Her 100% Italian heritage remained a proud part of her identity throughout her life, and she was proud to have obtained her Italian citizenship in 2024.

Her love for animals was evident in the deep affection she held for her dogs over the years and her loyal companions were never far from her side.

A lifelong Catholic, Vikki's faith provided strength throughout her life's journey. A previous breast cancer survivor, she carried herself with resilience and grace even during difficult times.

To those who knew her best—her family, friends, trivia teammates, book club, and countless others—Vikki will be remembered as bold, loving, endlessly entertaining, and always unapologetically herself. Her husband and daughters lovingly referred to her as their “diva,” a title she wore with pride—and one that perfectly captured the essence of who she was.
