Vincent C. DeRuchie of Laurel, Maryland, formerly of Chestertown, Maryland died at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, MD on March 18, 2005. He was 89.

Born on March 6, 1916 in Vineland, New Jersey, he was the son of the late Vincent C. and Hazel DeRuchie.

He graduated from Vineland High School and completed 2 years at Vineland State University before he entered the U.S. Army. He served during WWII in the 82nd Airborne as a paratrooper and was honorably discharged. On October 8, 1951 he married Hazel Virginia Peterson and they resided in Chestertown, Maryland. Mr. DeRuchie worked as an electrician with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers for 40 years until he retired. In 1984 he and his wife moved to Laurel, Maryland to be closer to their daughter.

In his younger years Mr. DeRuchie enjoyed playing golf, he also enjoyed traveling with his wife and daughter.

Mr. DeRuchie is survived by his daughter, Dani Dasch of Laurel, Maryland; a grandson, Anthony Black and his fiancée, Shannon Cofield of Laurel, Maryland.
